VACANCY: ENVIRONMENTAL INSPECTOR – PLANNING & ENVIRO DEPT

Applications are invited from suitably qualified persons to fill the position of **Environmental Inspector**, which has become vacant in the **Planning and Environment Department**.

Main Purpose of the job:

To enforce compliance with environmental management legislation and all relevant bye laws, policies and strategies in order to safeguard the environment of the jurisdiction of Mbabane.

Key Competencies (Knowledge and Skills):

- **Development of inventories:** Conduct visits to identify and create relevant annual inventories for all inspection areas containing address (physical and postal) and contact details of premise where applicable.
- **Conduct inspections in accordance with the level of service document:** Environmental Inspections in public and private schools, tertiary institutions, block yard, mortuaries, filling stations, garages, hardware and gas filling shops.
- **Environmental management of vacant plots:** Identify and conduct routine monitoring of overgrown plots, conduct follow up inspections, preparing for court cases for non-compliances.
- **Environmental management of projects and social screenings;** Conduct EIA audits and compile reports for projects within urban area; Landfill audits (internal & external); Assessments for cemetery operations & compliance. Conduct inspections for land leasing, special consent & subdivision applications; Investigate for environmental pollutants, Serve notices to owners of overgrown plots.
- **Routine cleaning of major roads and streets leading to the city:** Engage service provider; Scheduling, monitoring and supervision of the cleaning of the 44 streets of the city; Ensure streets cleaned on weekly basis;
- **Illegal dumps management:** identify illegal dumps, investigate and attend to illegal dumps, serve notices.
- **Public awareness and education:** Develop awareness IEC material / articles; Education and dissemination of information once per quarter; Conduct workshops and awareness campaigns.
- **Customer Care:** Investigate and attend to customer complaints; Serve notices
- Environmental awareness programs

Qualifications and Experience:

- Degree in Environmental Health Sciences (preferably major in Environmental Management)
- Three years' experience in a similar work environment
